



REACH Declaration

REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION, EVALUATION, AUTHORISATION AND RESTRICTION OF CHEMICALS

After review of the legislation, most notably the definition of an 'article' as defined in EC Regulation 1907/2006, Title II, Chapter 1, Article 7.1 (a) and (b), and the amendment Commission Regulation (EU) 2018/675 of 2nd May 2018, it is the view of Status Instruments Ltd that our products are considered 'articles'.

However, according to the definition in §7.1 (b), registration of an 'article' is only required if it contains a named substance that "is intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use". Status Instruments Ltd's analysis is that our products constitute non-registerable articles for their intended use.

Status Instruments Ltd confirms to the best of our knowledge that none of our products or packaging contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) on the REACH Candidate List (<https://echa.europa.eu/reach>) in a concentration above the 0.1% by weight allowable limit.
